The first art colony – at Manasquan – forms around 1880 as young artists fresh from European training in Germany, France and Italy begin to arrive, and the book includes work from these artists – Will Hicok Low, Theodore Robinson, Albert Grantley Reinhart, Charles Freeman and Caroline Coventry Haynes. The next generation – Edward Boulton, Ida Wells

Stroud, Julius Golz – trained in America, join and form new colonies to paint the unique light as well as the activities of the Shore. The passionate work created by these artists stands as an important, but unsung, chapter of American Impressionism and is celebrated in this book, establishing the important contribution to American art in general, and New Jersey's cultural heritage in particular.
